Hello Lions!

We are three quarters of the way through this Lions' year and the **Lions Community Outreach Foundation** is doing well, meeting the needs of the communities, thanks to the support of the District 22-C Lions Clubs. To date we have completed over **3,778** screenings at **49** events and collected **16,800** used eyeglasses and **162** hearing aids. And, the **Mobile Health Unit** has been racking up the miles going from one event to another throughout the district. In addition, we have processed over **135** requests for financial assistance and forwarded them to the local Lions Clubs. Without the help and support of the clubs, none of this could be possible. So again, I want to express my sincere thanks for all you do.

As many of you know, we are still looking for a permanent home for **LCOF**. We have rented both of the condo units we own to Connections Therapy Center and are renting temporary office space in Lanham to house the **LCOF** operations. Even in this economy, rent is fairly expensive. So we are working diligently to find suitable space at a reasonable price.

LCOF screening equipment and the **MHU** are constantly moving in and out of our operations center supporting the Lions Clubs, who are providing **sight saving services** to their communities. To provide these services to you we have hired a part time administrative assistant, **Yilia Jackson**, to process and track equipment, screening request, financial aid requests, eyeglass and hearing aid collections, and a host of other duties. She works four hours a day, five days a week throughout the year. In order to pay for all of this, we ask the local Lions Clubs for donations. Out of over **50 Lions Clubs** in our district, **31** have made financial contributions to **LCOF** through March. While we have worked diligently to hold our expenses down, the message here is, **we still need your financial support**. So dig down deep in your heart and consider making a donation to **LCOF**. Remember, when the **MHU** is rolling down the highway, it is an advertisement for all Lions Clubs. People remember that big blue bus and donate to your fundraisers, so that you can continue serving your community. All I am asking is that you send some of it back to **LCOF** so that we can continue serving you.
